- 1. About Daegu University
  - (1) Establishment: 1956
- (2) Campus: 2 (Gyeongsan Campus, Daegu Campus)
  - \* The largest campus in the nation (268.5ha)
  - \* Selected as one of the TOP 10 most beautiful campuses
  - \* Located in Daegu, the third largest city in South Korea
  - \* About 300km away from Seoul (1.5 hours from Seoul by KTX train)
- (3) Number of Students: around 16,000 (International students: about 1,600)
- (4) Colleges and Majors: 14 colleges and 90 majors

### 2. Specialized Fields

(1) Rehabilitation Science(Department: Vocational Rehabilitation, Speech Pathology, Physical Therapy, Rehabilitation Psychology, Rehabilitation Technology, Occupational Therapy)

  - (5) Mechanical Engineering(Department : Mechanical Engineering, Department of Integrated Mechanical Engineering) Goal: The cultivation of experts about innovation in industry of automobile parts Performance: Implement an Internship program in automobile part suppliers of Korea as well as overseas and certified by ABEEK

## 3. International Student Support Program

- (1) **Priority Assignment** of Housing named 국제관 for GKS students
- (2) 'One-stop' service for international students
  - \* Airport pick-up service
  - \* Support for immigration services (alien registration, visa extension etc.)
  - \* Dormitory and insurance support for students' living convenience
  - \* We have personnels who can speak English, Chinese, Mongolian, Vietnamese and other languages who can facilitate students' communication and ensure better adjustment.

## (3) Scholarship and Welfare Support

- \* Reasonable Housing named 국제관 for international students only
- \* Modern sports center serviced in a quote reasonable price available near the dormitory (golf, health club, etc)
- \* Besides the Global Korea Scholarship, Daegu University provides extra scholarships to encourage students' academic achievement and better thesis.

## (4) Discover Korean Culture Program

\* DU Discover Korean Culture program is provided an opportunity to experience Korean culture, history and nature cooperating with events, festivals, etc. conducted by local governments and agencies.

## (5) DU Mentoring Program

\* Operating a study group consisting of foreign and Korean students to help students understand their majors and adapt to school life by providing opportunities to improve their major studies and Korean language skills.

## (6) Administrative, Counselling

- \* Daily Support: We keep our students informed about important information such as scholarship and other useful information through email and our web-site.
- \* Academic Counselling: At the completion of their Korean Language program and their entrance to the Graduate School, students are provided with counselling by their advisers and assistants from each department. Daegu University does its best to minimize the difficulties students may encounter in living and studying.

\* International student counseling Center, International Student Day events, regular meetings for international students, etc.










