

- 2025 : Half of total population in deficiency of water resources (WRI)





### Change of Global Temperature

# Global Anthropogenic GHG Emissions




### Food Insecurity

→ 0.08 ha/person


## Estimated Regional Distribution of Hunger in 2009 (in million) and Increase from 2008 (in %)



## Changes in Korea's Landscape and Economy

*\*\* Seongbuk-dong area, Seoul, Republic of Korea in the 1950s and present*



### PAST

GNI per capita in 1953 = USD 67

Population density = 222 people/km<sup>2</sup>

Growing stock per ha = 6 m<sup>3</sup>

### PRESENT

GNI per capita in 2010 = USD 20,000

Population density = 485 people/km<sup>2</sup>

Growing stock per ha = 126 m<sup>3</sup>

# History of Reforestation in Korea

We planted 12 billion trees in degraded areas from 1962 !!!

# Saemaul Undong (SU) and Korean community development



## Saemaul Undong

- Initiated in 1971
- Three slogans: diligence, self-help and cooperation
- Factors promoted by SU:
  - ① Educational factor (human resources capacity building developed)
  - ② Environmental factor (environment improved)
  - ③ Social factor (income increase emphasized)
  - ④ Creative power of human being ([more dynamic society built](#))


## Change in the way of thinking

- CAN DO, WILL DO, MUST DO spirit
- NEED-virus: hungry for food, learning, clean leadership, etc.)

## Investments! Increasing Value of Forests

### *Providing economic foundation for local communities*

- Investing a budget of USD 2.0 bil (nurture, protection, utilization) creates an economic value of USD 100 bil



- \* One 30-year-old pine tree for landscape values approximately USD 500
- Pine tree with high aesthetic value: over USD 1 mil

♣ How can the Korean Government invest for the increasing value of forest?

- ① Preparation of the land → restoration, SFM, watershed management
- ② Protection and conservation → combating forest fire, Baekdu-Daegan Conservation Area
- ③ R&D in forestry → renewable energy, BT, ET
- ④ Incubating → forest recreation, forest education, etc.

## New Paradigm of Using Forest Resources

**Forests as health assets → healing forest, recreation village**

- 30 mil mountain hikers, USD 2.4 bil/yr reduced for medical expenses
- 77% of people undergoing long-term healthcare prefer to stay in healing forest (7 healing forests are available)

**New possibilities with natural substances & bio-energy**

- 2,104 species among 4,597 species of forest plants are edible or medicinally useful

**Adding value of forest resources using bio-technology**



*Illicium anisatum* - Tamiflu



*Hovenia dulcis* – Healthy liver



*Taxus cuspidata* – Anti-cancer



*Ginkgo biloba* – Blood circulation







## Changes in educational curricula

## Producing experts through field practices

to produce forestry experts with high quality and specialized skills

## Capacity building of human resources

e.g. tree doctor, information and networking  
exploring new medicines from plants  
FAO, CIFOR, World Bank, etc.



## Changes in educational curricula

### International education programme

- Active support program on the study of forests to improve education
- Tapping foreign experts on a particular field for the improvement of the programs etc.
- Recruit/exchange foreign students
- Contribution of trained students in forestry-related institutes and industries



## Changes in educational curricula

## Investing on research and development

- UN Eco-Peace Leadership Training Center: need for education in developing countries
- Need for providing extensive network in doing research and activities related to the rehabilitation and management of forests.

Collaborative partnership and networking among universities, institutes, government, industries and private companies




